WARNING! Risk of electric shock

Before starting up the appliance, read the operating instructions carefully and keep them together with the guarantee, receipt. If possible, keep the outer packaging as well. If you pass this appliance on to others, please pass on the operating instructions as well.



· READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS

- Make sure the voltage in your outlet is the same as the voltage indicated on the appliance's rating label.
- · Use only for household.
- · Do not touch hot Plates surfaces. Use handle.
- To protect against risk of electric shock, do not immerse the cord, plug or cooking unit in water or any other liquid.
- · Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning appliance.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged has malfunctioned or has been damaged in any manner. In order to avoid the risk of an electric shock, never try to repair the Sandwich Maker yourself. Take it to an authorized service station for examination and repair. An incorrect reassembly could present a risk of electric shock when the Sandwich Maker is used.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the manufacturer may result in fire, electrical shock, or risk of injury to persons.
- · Do not use outdoors or for commercial purposes.
- Do not let power cord hang over the edge of the table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- · Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner or heated oven.
- · Do not intend to operate by means of an external timer or separate remote-control system.
- · Unplug the unit when finished using.
- Extreme caution must be exercised when moving an appliance.
- · The temperature of accessible surfaces may be high when the appliance is operating.
- The appliances are not intended to be operated by means of an external timer or separate remote-control system.
- · Warning: The surfaces are liable to get hot during use.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or its service agent or a similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety
- · Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

BEFORE FIRST USE

- · Read all instructions carefully and keep them for future reference.
- · Remove all packaging
- Clean the Cooking Plates by wiping a sponge or cloth dampened in warm water.
 DO NOT IMMERSE THE UNIT AND DO NOT RUN WATER DIRECTLY ONT THE COOKING SURFACES.
- · Dry with a cloth or paper towel.
- · For best results, lightly coat the cooking plates with a little cooking oil or cooking spray.

Notice: When your Sandwich Maker is heated for the first time, it may emit slight smoke or odor. This is normal with many heating appliances. This does not affect the safety of your appliance.

HOW TO USE

- Close the Sandwich Maker and plug it into the wall outlet, you will notice that the power light will turn on, indicating that the Sandwich Maker has begun preheating.
- 2. It will take approximately 2~3 minutes to reach baking temperature, the preheating is completed when the ready light will turn on.
- 3. Open the lid, put the bread or other foods on the bottom cooking plate.
- 4. Close the lid. the ready light will turn off, which means it will start heating.
- 5. Cook for about 2 to 4 minutes, the ready light turns on again, or until golden brown, adjusting the time to suit your own individual taste.
- 6. When the foods is cooked use the handle to open the lid. Remove the foods with the help of a plastic spatula. Never use metal tongs or a knife as these can cause damage to the non-stick coating of the cook plates.
- 7. Once you are finished cooking, disconnect the plug from the wall outlet and leave unit open to cool.

HOW TO REPLACE HEATING PLATES





MAKE SURE THE HOTPLATES ARE NOT HOT BEFORE YOU START REPLACING THEM. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES TOUCH HOTPLATES!

- 1. To replace the hotplates, press the buttons shown in the picture.
- 2. Plates should pop out of the latches.
- 3. Remove the plate and replace it with the plate you wish to install.
- 4. Press the plate down until you hear a click.

CLEANING AND CARE

- · Always unplug the Sandwich Maker and allow it to cool before cleaning. The unit is easier to clean when slightly warm. There is no need to disassemble Sandwich Maker for cleaning. Never immerse the Sandwich Maker in water or place in dishwasher.
- Wipe cooking plates with a soft to remove food residue. For baked on food residue squeeze some warm water mixed with detergent over the food residue then clean with a non abrasive plastic scouring pad or place wet kitchen paper over the grill to moisten the food residue.
- · Do not use anything abrasive that can scratch or damage the non-stick coating.
- Do not use metal utensils to remove your foods, they can damage the non-stick surface.
- Wipe the outside of the Sandwich Maker with a damp cloth only. Do not clean the outside with any abrasive scouring pad or steel wool, as this will damage the finish. Do not immerse in water or any other liquid.
- · Do not place in the dishwasher.
- Remove and empty the drip tray after each use and wash the tray in warm, soapy water. Avoid the use of scouring pads or harsh detergents as they may damage the surface. Rinse and dry thoroughly with a clean, soft cloth and replace.

STORAGE

- · Always unplug the Sandwich Maker before storage.
- · Always make sure the Sandwich Maker is cool and dry before storing.
